Long term unemployed profile

- low skilled, low educated
- in underdeveloped region
- low assets, small savings,
- (some of them are Roma, some of them in segregated settlements)



Activational works

- since 2004, several 100 thousands
- still registered unemployed
- fixed reward of 60€/mo per 10 hours of work/week
- fixed subsidy to villages
- control of process, not results
- social lockin effect



Reconstruction of castles

- in 2011
- 2 castles
- real working contract
- (50 people)







anti-flooding works

- in 2011
- real working contract
- several thousand people
- 200 villages





Common points

- should
 - -synergy effects
 - focused on control of results (not process control)
 - -small administration
 - -effective in situations where 1 in 4 is applicable
